Summer is here and the heat is on. We have been working on improving the school building in many ways. Some of you know Karen Karras. She has been coming in the mornings and painting the outside, which really looks GREAT! Thanks Karen. We are reworking the main doors, installing some new locks and have planted six trees to help shade the building. We received estimates of over \$4,000 to install air conditioning in our half of the building; so that convinced us that a fan system was a better idea for under \$70. It will keep the temperature in the main room around 80 degrees in the hot days versus 100+ degrees without. Plus, we are working on installing the exterior shades which will help even more in the sunny afternoons.

The book store is waiting for zoning issues to be taken care of, and the renovations that may go along with that. The store sure could use some help to make these changes. We have made a purchase offer for the building we are using.

We are part of the new, Media Taskforce of New York Conference that was set up last month. This will allow the stations to help each other in programming, in technical ways and to assist the Conference in any way we can. We currently have six radio stations in the conference. Our (donated) sound booth is setup and working. The last glitch was fixed today, we hope. Now we can have two people recording independently of each other. This prospective station will not be owned or operated by us (FCC rules forbid), but we want to do everything we can to help. The first choice is to have it in Ithaca, but maybe between Cortland and Ithaca.

It is amazing how God works. We have a few hundred dollars or less, but last month's bills are paid and we are on the air broadcasting God's Word, 24 hours a day. We solicit your donations, whether it's for our \$3,000 monthly operating expense, book store, or building improvements. You can be sure that your money is being spent wisely.
