Greetings from a radio station in the making! It is interesting to see how the Lord is assembling this station, piece by piece, with a hundred and twenty two days til, what I call, "do or die day": the day to be on the air or lose the FCC Construction Permit, no matter what.

What really drives me about outreach is hearing what is happening with this world. Whether it's natural disasters or human disasters. Just yesterday again, I was reading my news from the Fox News web site and they reported on a Houston Texas couple who abused their six month old girl in the worst of ways, so unimaginable, even the news was somewhat vague. Please pray for the little baby. A few days before that, another wicked story. They seem to be like waves, never ending. These parents should be treated like they have treated their kids, and even killed via the laws of the government. But then again, don't we all deserve the death penalty?

The Lord is coming soon! Right when we least expect it. Then it will be too late, too late! They that are holy, will remain holy and be taken with Him. They that are wicked will remain wicked and will soon face eternal death. Then all the pains of the earth will be burned away. It is better to repent now, than later. Do you have sins that need the forgiveness that only Jesus can give you?

On the topic of programming, we have recorded five health segments this week on the body in a local program called, "Body, Mind, and Spirit". We hope to make this a benchmark program for us. Soon, we will be starting two interview programs of local people. "Pastoral Interviews" is a program interviewing local pastors and the other will be "Testimonies & World Views". We are also working at Bible readings, an adult lesson study, kids stories, devotionals and more.

January 23<sup>rd</sup>, we had our first Open House. Due to the snow the day before, many were not able to come. In all, we had about sixty people, some even drove an hour or more to attend. We had a good time, showing people the technology that will be behind transmitted radio waves. As guests arrived, we handed them a large envelope, filled with station information, good reading materials, along with a coloring book and CD. For those who were not able to attend and would like a personal tour, contact us and we'll set up a time that's convenient for you.

The mono pole is still laying on the ground here. The manufacturer needs to correct some things before it can be erected. The EAS (Emergency Alert System), transmitter, modulation meter, transmitter remote controller, and a dual mic pre amp, have been ordered and should be here soon. We recently received a new broadcasting mic, transmission line system, and finally got the recording computer fixed to a good working order.

This all comes with a price tag. It all depends on how it's figured, but we need to pay for the above equipment, repay our loans and pay for the bills and very soon upcoming expenses, totaling about \$30,000. We would like to get some basic insurance also if we can afford to acquire it. This month, we received our 501(c)(3) status with the IRS, so all contributions are tax exempt, dating back to October 31,2000, the date of incorporating.

We would like to thank all the people who have helped us thus far. We have had donated labor, heavy equipment work, engineering consulting, finances, reduced prices from vendors, computer help and many others. Not to forget, the New York Conference and the Fingerlakes Adventist School for allowing us to use their land and building. Last year, we received about \$14,600, and this year, approximately \$2,300 toward our \$70,000 startup expense, which includes a new building. Thank you!

If you know someone who is electronically minded, we'll be needing help setting up the broadcasting equipment.
